Course description:

What place does law have in addressing the unprecedented environmental challenges humanity faces today?

We will look at the values and principles that guide environmental law, and their assimilation into legal frameworks.

We'll discuss, looking at international law, national legislation, case-law and case-studies, the way sustainability and environmental issues are being dealt with by specific legal instruments, and will question whether these provide effective mechanisms for addressing the challenges we face.

The effectiveness of International Environmental Agreements

The enforcement of environmental law

Environmental assessment

Climate Change litigation
