





To commute between Lisbon and Carcavelos, please check the following mobility solutions:

TRAIN

The best way to get to the new campus is by train taking the Cascais train line in Cais do Sodré. When exiting the train at the Carcavelos station you can either walk for 20 minutes or take a short bus ride (MobiCascais). At the Carcavelos station and on-campus, there is also a bike sharing and renting system available which can be integrated into the combined pass so you can easily cycle from the station to the campus.

Nova SBE has special prices on mobility solutions: 40 % discount over the market fare on CP passes in Lisbon's Urban Areas, MobiCascais - Nova SBE Buscas bus, and the CP Nova SBE MobiCascais Bus (integrated pass).

BUS FROM CENTRAL LISBON

There is a direct bus service exclusively for Nova SBE. This bus service travels from central Lisbon to the Carcavelos Campus with several trips to and from the campus during the day, in the hours of greater affluence. **Bus passes are sold online.** www.novasbe.busup.com

Well-being and personal development

The Student Development Office's (SDO) main goal is to help students fulfill their personal needs and promote their well-being. Their programs focus on Personal Development and Psychologic Support and are aimed at students who intend to explore their potential, improve their relationships, and their quality of life, but also at students who experience moments of stress, anxiety, depression, and other psychological and emotional concerns.

STUDENT DEVELOPMENT OFFICE'S PROGRAMS

Student Counseling

Students can apply for psychological accompaniment and counseling provided by a psychologist specialized in Education. Typically, students seek support for problems related to stress, anxiety, difficulties in integration, etc. This service is open to everyone. All you need to do is send an email to schedule a chat with Edite Oliveira, Nova SBE's trained psychologist.

Support for Academic and Social Integration (PAIAS)

PAIAS is a mentoring project aimed at facilitating the integration and the adaptation of undergraduate students during their first year at Nova SBE. PAIAS mentors are senior students who provide academic and social support to first-year students upon their arrival.

Promotion of Academic Success Program

A series of workshops focused on developing students' soft skills, study methods and techniques, such as teamwork, avoiding procrastination, etc., with the objective of improving the students' academic success.

Peer Tutoring Program

One-to-one academic support on a weekly basis from students who have done well on a particular subject (tutors) to students (tutees) seeking support to have better performances. Each meeting lasts for 90 minutes, where the tutor answers questions, clarifies doubts and/or does exercises with the tutee.

Student card

Your student card is your official Nova SBE ID and it provides access to certain facilities including study rooms, the library, and photocopiers. The online submission to request your card was sent directly to students by the Academic Services.

Your Student ID number is the same as the prefix of your institutional email (ex: 99999@novasbe.pt).

You will be informed when you can pick-up your student card at the on-campus Santander branch. The student card provider is Santander Bank, however, the card is not associated with a bank account. Students interested in opening a bank account at Santander will be able to do so at the bank agency on campus.

For international students, Santander now offers to manage the request for the Portuguese fiscal number (a requirement to open bank accounts in Portugal) on the students' behalf.


EUROPEAN UNION (EU) CITIZENS

If you are coming to Portugal from a country which doesn't require an entry Visa you still have to register at the Lisbon City Hall.

- Valid ID card/passport (the original and a photocopy);
- Proof of address in Lisbon;
- Sworn Statement.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Portuguese visa processing can take anywhere from two weeks to up to three months, so it is advisable to start your visa application as soon as you receive the Acceptance Letter.



NON-EUROPEAN (NON-UE) CITIZENS

Students coming from countries outside the EU, EEA, and Switzerland are required to ask for a Student Visa (longer than three months and up to one year) or a Residence Permit (for stays longer than one year).

Step 1: Request the Visa/Residence Permit

Schedule an appointment at the Portuguese embassy or consulate in your home country as soon as you receive the Acceptance Letter.

Step 2: Documents

Depending on your nationality, duration of stay, and type of service you are applying for, some or all of the following standard documents may be required:

- Acceptance letter, in which the correct dates
 of your studies are stated (either the Admissions
 team (regular students) or the International
 Mobility team students on a mobility program)
 will issue this document);
- Visa Form:
- Two passport photos (in color);
- Your passport and copies of your previous visas (passports must be valid for a minimum of 6 months);
- A copy of your return ticket reservation;
- Travel insurance to cover you for the Schengen area;
- · Flight dates and times;
- Accommodation plans for the duration of your stay (e.g. hotel reservation);
- Proof of sufficient funds for the duration of your stay;
- Proof of civil status (married, children, etc.);
- Proof of economic status (employed, self- employed, student, retired, etc.);
- Copy of your Criminal Record (if you have been living elsewhere for over one year, this should be issued by that country and not by your home country).

RENEWING YOUR VISA

You will need to renew your visa once in Portugal as the first emission usually lasts for a period that does not cover the full duration of your studies. Upon arrival, book your appointment with SEF - Serviço de Estrangeiros e Fronteiras (Immigration and Borders Service) for renewal purposes, as times varies between **two to five months to get an appointment.**

You must book an appointment in a SEF delegation, which can be done in two ways:

Warning: when you call this number, you will hear an automatic message in Portuguese with the options listed below. In case you don't understand Portuguese, please press the numbers as described:

- First, press 1 (you will be selecting the option to book an appointment);
- Second, press 3 (you will be stating that you live in the Lisbon or Cascais area. If you live near the Carcavelos Campus don't worry. It's included in this area);
- Finally, press 3 again (you will be stating that you want to book an appointment to renew your visa). You will then be put on hold, waiting for someone to pick up the call. Do not be surprised to hear a message in Portuguese, it is the general information that SEF provides while you are on hold. When an officer picks up, please ask them to speak in English. You can say "Desculpe, não falo Português. Inglês?" which states that you do not speak Portuguese and suggest speaking in English.

- Choose the option that says "Prorogation of Permanence";
- Choose the city (Lisboa or Cascais) and click "Prorrogações de Permanência";
- Fill in your personal data.

Campus safety is a priority for the school. Nova SBE has been taking some decisive steps to strengthen its security and has agreed to reinforce, with the help of the Public Safety Police, security on campus and its surrounding areas.

Prevention is the best protection!

- When at an ATM, check your surroundings and protect your PIN code from others;
- Don't let strangers distract you from your belongings;
- Do not carry large amounts of money or values in your wallet or bag;
- Keep your belongings close to you and secure them with one hand, if possible;
- Carry your keys preferably in a pocket inside your clothes and not inside your bag/wallet;
- In case of theft, do not react. Try to memorize the thief's features and contact security on campus or call 112. The nearest Police Station is here.

Bank account

As your student card is issued by Santander bank, a partner of Nova SBE, you may also want to open a bank account in the Carcavelos Campus branch, upon your arrival at Nova SBE.

For international students, Santander now offers to manage the request for the Portuguese fiscal number (a requirement to open bank accounts in Portugal) on students' behalf.

The Multibanco system (ATM) is widespread and very convenient. With it, you can withdraw up to 200€ a day with your Santander bank card, at any time.

SIM card

Most students will want a Portuguese SIM card to stay connected to friends and family, and be able to make/ receive phone calls without roaming charges.

Our Students' Union can provide you with a SIM card from Yorn (a Portuguese Operator), upon your arrival, for free.

Most prepaid packages are not very expensive and can start from 10€ a month or even less. You can check the mobile phone companies below:

Portuguese language course


