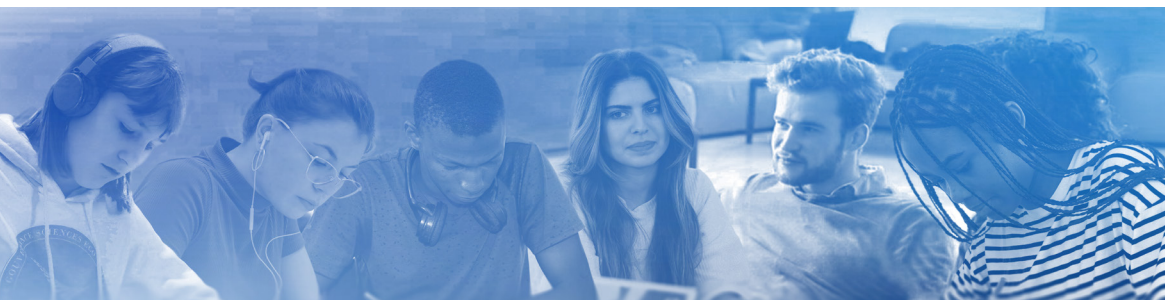

## Application Procedure

Students should fill in the online application form available on the FGSES website, and send scanned copies of the following documents to [exchange.fgses@um6p.ma](mailto:exchange.fgses@um6p.ma)

- A recent photograph
- Copy of passport
- Up-to-date academic transcript
- Provisional Learning Agreement

Once application forms are processed and reviewed, accepted incoming students will receive by July, an acceptance email together with a practical information sheet.

## Academics

- The FGSES adopts the ECTS credit scheme (1 credit=25 hours of study).
- Incoming exchange students are entitled to enroll up to 35 ECTS credits per semester.
- Language of instruction: English, French & Arabic.
- Incoming exchange students will be given access to all FGSES courses in undergraduate and Master's level, as long as they have the necessary prerequisites.
- No official language document is required: Incoming students should have a level in English at least B2 in English or in French and students will not be required to submit an official language test result for the exchange program.

## On-site facilities

The FGSES/UM6P Rabat campus has state of the art facilities including connected-teaching blocs, library, catering, accommodation, sport center... Please visit our website for a broader overview of the campus' environment.

## Accommodation

Incoming students can opt for on-campus accommodation, ranging from individual studios to flat sharing with up to 3 students.

## Visa & Insurance

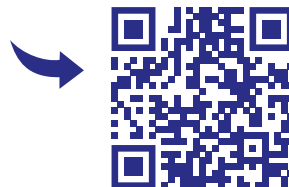
**Health insurance:** Incoming exchange students must hold a health insurance policy meeting the following requirements:

- It must cover the entire duration of your stay in Morocco.
- it must guarantee the return to your own country in case of serious illness.
