LETTER OF CERTIFICATION

This letter is to certify that English is one of the official languages in Singapore. English is also the language of instruction for all our courses in Singapore Management University (SMU).

All Singaporean SMU students would have attended a minimum of 15 years of education in English prior to admittance into the university.

For admissions of international students, they are expected to demonstrate a good command of both oral and written English. SMU requires them to meet the minimum scores of the following English proficiency test:

- IELTS: A minimum overall score of 7.0 with reading score of at least 7.0 and writing score of at least 6.5
- TOEFL iBT (internet-based test): A minimum score of 93, with at least 22 each for both reading and writing
- TOEFL PBT (paper-based test): A minimum score of 583, with at least 5.5 for TWE (Test of Written English and 50 for reading)
