### **Jewish Identity**

- Assimilation: Mixed Marriages
- Numbers Down: A drop of 20,000 in 2007
- Only 33% of mixed marriage couples feel Jewish identity is important, compared with 70% of Jewish married couples.
- Young Jews identify with their non-Jewish peers and behave similarly.

#### **Ties To Israel**

- No memory of the 1948, 1967 wars
- Media conveys a skewed image of Israel: Intifada, Lebanon

- The 1990s 15,000 visits by young Jews per year
- No demand for subsidized trips to Israel
- The 1990s only 1,500 students visit Israel
- Today 40,000 students visit Israel annually

# **Status of The Young Generation of Diaspora Jews - Third Circle:**



#### **Jewish Community**

- Number of unmarried Jews rising
- Sense of alienation from the Jewish establishment
- Being part of the Jewish establishment perceived as "uncool"
- Membership in Jewish organizations declining
- Rise in number of those defining themselves as "Just Jewish"
- Jewish federations and donors seeking independent channels
- Non-establishment enterprises are creative and flourishing
