About the survey

Data collection during May 9-15, 2023

Among Israeli Arab citizens (including mixed cities)

Sample size: 502 respondents (age 18+)

Sample error: ±4.4 percent




Opinions among Arab citizens on the wave of protests in Israel


75.9% Support the protests

47.9% Believe that this issue concerns the Arab public


59.7% Think that Arab citizens should take a more active role in the protests

Will Arab citizens accept a constitution based on Israel's Declaration of Independence?






Has the recent violence in Arab society reduced your sense of individual security and that of your family?




■ To a large or great extent ☐ To some extent or not at all
